

Commitment

The program will be a total of 8 days spread out over several months and will be delivered in person and virtually. This blended learning approach will allow participants to balance their professional commitments while actively engaging in the program.

What's Covered

- 85% of the regular registration fee is funded by OCFP. Successful applicants will pay \$1275 + HST, which represents 15% of the regular registration fee.
- Hotel stay for the in-person modules at the Royal Sonesta Hotel (a ~7-minute walk to Rotman)
- Travel (air fare/train fare/personal vehicle at km rates of \$0.61)
- One group meal during the first in-person module
- Meals during in-person program time organized by Rotman
- Some support towards locum coverage



Who Should Apply

We encourage applications from:

- Those who have demonstrated leadership potential and interests.
- Those who are currently serving or aspiring to serve in system-level or regional leadership roles within the healthcare system (e.g., OHTs).
- Those who identify as Indigenous persons, Black and racialized persons, persons with disability, women, and persons from the 2SLGBTQIA+ community.
- Those who work in rural or remote communities.
- Those who care for marginalized communities.
